

Instructions for finishing your laminate gliding door

Procedure for removing the active panel on a gliding door

- For finishing your laminate gliding door, we recommend using a water-based stain, paint or varnish.

ATTENTION: Never use sandpaper.

- When applying the finish, follow the product manufacturer's recommendations.
- The door manufacturer is not responsible for the results obtained.
- We recommend testing the finish first on the sample provided.
- Before applying your finish, follow the enclosed instructions when removing your active panel.



01

Tools required

- Rubber mallet
- Ergo-grip 6-in-1 painter's tool with steel head, high carbon steel blade (Richard brand, model no. RUB-119)



02

Insert the point of the blade between the meeting rail and the door



03

Insert the edge of the blade as far as possible



04

Push and turn the blade to release the clips of the meeting rail



05

Remove the meeting rail by pulling it towards the bottom and sliding the blade upwards



06

6.0 Remove the meeting rail.



07

Unlock and open the door



08

Position the door in the centre of the opening and lift the door



09

Pull on the door to release it from the frame



10

The door has now been removed

6.1 Make sure that the rollers are at the lowest position possible (see the installation guide)
